Average age of mothers, giving birth in 2015

In 2015, the average age of all women giving birth, was 27.4 years and for first-time mothers 24.7 years. When the development over time is considered, it appears that the average age of first-time mothers have increased by 1.8 years over the last 15 years, while the average age of all women giving birth is largely unchanged.

Women living in settlements have their first child 3.2 years earlier than women in towns and here we do not see quite the same development over time.

On population we can present detailed, coherent and consistent statistical information for:

Population estimates: 1977-2016 Births: 1973-2015 Deaths: 1973-2015 Cause of Deaths: 1990-2013 Migration: 1993-2015 Internal migration: 1993-2015 In creating these tables the present administrative subdivision has been used and municipalities are as defined on January 1st 2009. At lower levels we use 2 concepts; districts are equivalent with municipalities prior to 2009 and localities. A locality is a place and can be any town, settlement, station, mine and can be inhabited or not. For definition we use the one ASIAQ (<u>www.asiaq.gl</u>) has determined. The Asiaq list on localities is as of now not complete with regards to historical localities.

To ensure consistency at detailed levels we have revised our data once again. Some minor inconsistencies have been corrected, and some differences can be found in comparing the revised tables with previously publications.



From summary table 3 we learn that 855 children were born in 2015, which are 49 more compared to 2014. The relatively small birth cohorts from the

mid-seventies has for most now completed their fertile period. They will be replaced by relatively larger birth cohorts in the coming years.

The fertility pattern has been unchanged with total fertility at reproduction level. Graph 1 shows the total fertility rates over the past 10 years. 


Graph 2. Migrations 1993-2015
